New Business:

Comment Period:

Homeowners discussed the Arborist Report and the Native Growth Protection Areas (NGPA).

- 1) Question about tree debris removal from a recent storm. The landscapers were unusually busy and missed that week, but cleaned up the common areas the next week.
- 2) Question about trimming of branches and the removal of trees in the NGPA. The Arborist Report identifies which trees are in need of removal or trimming. Only the identified trees can legally be removed/trimmed.
- 3) Bob explained that trees were removed in Q1 and Q2 that had been identified in the Nov. 2021 Arborist Report as needing to be removed.

A homeowner asked when wood chips were added to the tot lots. – Linda explained that the wood chips were added in early 2022.

A homeowner suggested there are rat and squirrel issues due to homeowners feeding them. – There are no rules in the CC&R's to prevent feeding of the animals.
